Sometimes we miss the fact that the last words of Jesus are not in the gospels or the Book of Acts, but the Book of Revelation. In the second to last chapter of the last book in the Bible, Jesus mentions he is making all things new. Newness! The older we get the more imperative it is to embrace newness. At Westview, we have many new initiatives coming in 2022:

Town Hall Meetings after worship in Fellowship Hall January 9th and 23rd

I have a great deal of information to share with you regarding how we finished the financial year at Westview and our budget for mission and ministry in 2022. I also have additional information as a follow up on the town hall meetings last fall that I hope will have a big, positive impact in 2022. Please make it a priority to come to these important town hall meetings! The town halls will also lead us up to our annual meeting on Sunday January 30th right after worship. Our wonderful Deacons will be hosting a spaghetti luncheon on that day as well.

Coming Sunday afternoons during Lent: "ElderSoul" with Dr. Dan and Carol Kortsch

As many of us enter into the later stages of life, what does it mean not to just grow older, but to grow as an "elder"? What are the gifts, challenges, and opportunities of this phase of life?

These questions and more will be our companions on a five-week journey during Lent. I will be team teaching with Carol Kortsch, an experienced guide and beautiful soul in helping people discover the elder within them. This important Lenten journey will include teaching, small group discussion, some homework, tough questions about aging, and learning to follow more closely the threads the Holy Spirit is weaving in you at this stage in life.. As Carol states:

ElderSoul is a call to mature adults who are walking a life-long soulful process. It is for those who long to know their place in Earth community and desire a true and deepening elderhood.

This is a five-week commitment on Sunday afternoons. Enrollment will be limited, and a small donation will be asked for those who participate.

A Year-Long Cohort with Dr. Dan on "Finding Your Wild" March – October 2022

"You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off the False self . . . and to put on the True Self" (Ephesians 4:22,24) When and where were you taught how to put on the True Self? The church in recent times has largely failed people in this endeavor.

Another program the Spiritual Journeys ministry area is providing in 2022 is the opportunity for a year-long experiential dive into my book "Finding Your Wild," which is about how to put on the True Self and put off the False Self. Heavily influenced by the work of Dr. Bill Plotkin and the Animas Valley Institute, the cohort is not merely a book study but a dive into the eight stages of spiritual growth and how to discern how the risen Christ is working in my life. Be forewarned: this cohort is highly experiential with practice in spiritual disciplines such as prayer, healing and wholeness work, dreamwork, griefwork, wanders out in God's creation, community building, and journaling. While technically more of a nine month than twelve-month commitment, the year-long will include: Invitations for weekly solo wanders in the wild; monthly council either in-person and/or on Zoom; four quarterly retreats TBD; a five-day camping intensive in RMNP July 13-17, 2022.

Space is limited to twelve participants. When we meet in person indoors, we will be following COVID protocols of mask wearing and social distancing. We will also have protocols for meal preparation at the intensive in July. While there is no cost for the year-long, there will be fees associated with the retreats (hopefully at Highlands Camp) and the five-day camping intensive. There is also an application process to make sure this is the right program for you, which will be available after the first of the year. We wish a Happy New Year to all of our volunteers, donors, partner churches, community friends and shoppers! We thank you for all your effort, care and help in keeping all the parts of The ROUND PANTRY moving smoothly as we navigated a second pandemic year of providing food to those who are food insecure.

We closed 2021 with a single pantry in December. With the help of Community Food Share and purchases of 5,000 additional pounds of canned goods, meat and fresh produce, we were able to distribute over 40,000 pounds of food to 845 households.



As we move into 2022, we, like you, are wondering what the next year will bring for our community or the wider world. What we do know is that the amazing fellowship of volunteers that plan, support and make The ROUND PANTRY a blessing to those in need will carry on. We ask for your continued support and prayers.
