ROUND PANTRY Summer Notes

The ROUND PANTRY continues its service to the community as one of the Community Food Share [CFS] distributing agencies. CFS describes the need for this service on its website:

34,000 people in our service area are struggling with hunger, including 7,300 children. That's 9% of our neighbors.

Many people don't realize how prevalent hunger is in our community [especially, with the lingering impacts of COVID restrictions and closures] because it's not always what you expect. Most of the people we serve are working, but their wages are not high enough to cover living expenses. Instead, they must choose between food, housing, healthcare, or utilities. Many of them stretch their food budget by skipping meals or purchasing inexpensive, unhealthy food.

Shopper numbers at The ROUND PANTRY are fluctuating up and down (trending down) as people are able to return to work, take trips or get together with extended family. And, the need for food is still a very real presence in our own neighborhood – especially for our elderly and physically challenged friends and parents with children home for summer vacation.

Summer is always a time that things change. This year is no different. Our volunteers – especially our high school youth – are working summer jobs and individuals and families are able to go on vacation. So, we need the help of other volunteers. Now that many are vaccinated and masking has become optional, we are seeing the faces [double meaning intended] of volunteers returning to Pantry. We can use your help and encourage you to invite a friend to sign up with you.

A few other notes:

Would the person(s) who borrowed one of the small, digital scales from the Pantry please return it to the Kitchen counter? It is virtually new, in it's original light gray box labeled ROUND PANTRY.

And, we would appreciate return of the short, red carpet cleaner (labeled ROUND PANTRY) that was removed from the closet on the north side of Fellowship Hall.

THANK YOU for continuing to donate plastic grocery bags! [We have a good stock of egg cartons on hand and have no more room to store any. Please <u>do not</u> bring egg cartons to the church.]


Church Office Information
