In addition to the town hall meetings on Zoom, we will be emailing a priority survey to the congregation. We will also have a larger town hall meeting for everyone to share the results.

creating a long range plan for Westview church facilities.





# Outreach MInistry

#### From the COMMUNITY FOOD SHARE website

34,000 people in our service area are struggling with hunger, including 7,300 children. That's 9% of our neighbors.

Many people don't realize how prevalent hunger is in our community, because it's not always what you expect. Most of the people we serve are working, but their wages are not high enough to cover living expenses. Instead, they must choose between food, housing, healthcare, or utilities. Many of them stretch their food budget by skipping meals or purchasing inexpensive, unhealthy food. That's where we come in.

The ROUND PANTRY is proud to be a distributing agency of Community Food Share and humbled to be serving more than 800 households every second and fourth week of each month. Community Food Share delivers as much as 30,000 lbs. of food each Pantry week. Food is also purchased to fill out nutrition categories (such as peanut butter) because of generous monetary donations.

The ROUND PANTRY is fortunate to have the support of Westview Presbyterian Church! Shoppers, volunteers, church partners, and people across the community know of and marvel at the mission of Westview.

And, we continue to marvel at our volunteer ranks that continue to grow with people drawn to being part of a fellowship of those who seek to literally be "the hands and feet of Christ."

Currently, we need to fill new volunteer positions that will take place outside of usual Pantry hours (thus limiting personal contact.)

We are looking for:

Shoppers: place orders with local stores

Drivers: pick up orders at local stores (pick-up sized loads, lifting required)

Sanitize safety vests: done in your home (requires picking up vests)
