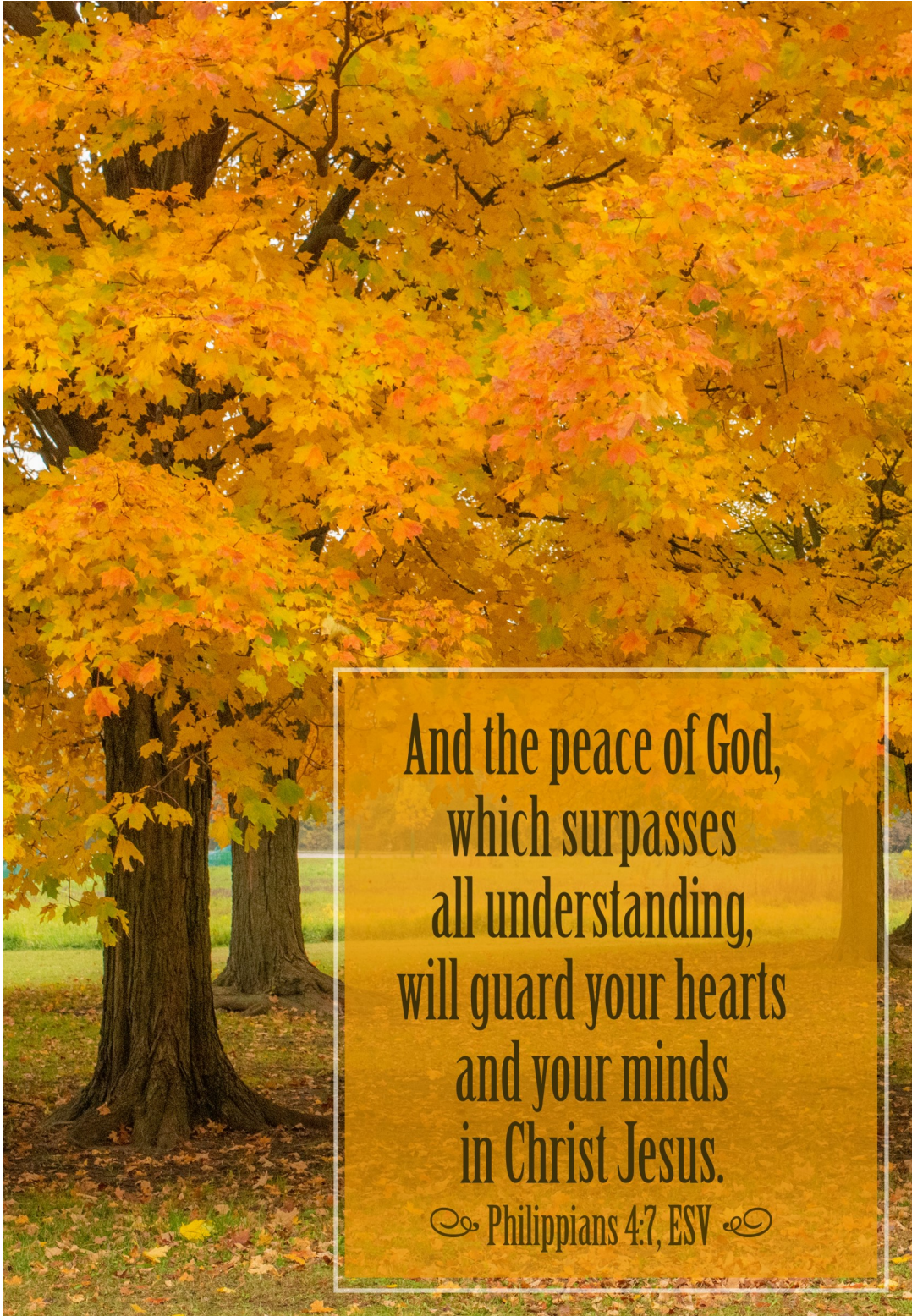

Message from Gatherings MA

The Kick-off Sunday Chili/Taco gathering was enjoyed by about 40 Westviewers and guests.

According to the Food and Agriculture Organization, nearly 750 million people worldwide are affected by food insecurity. People across Europe and especially in Africa have had their food supply threatened and/or cut off due to the Ukrainian conflict and resulting food shortages and supply disruption. People in Pakistan are living in the midst of unprecedented flooding that has taken away homes, stores of food, and agricultural fields. Other countries, including the U.S. seeing rising numbers of hungry people in the wake of the pandemic.

Hunger Free Colorado maintains a regularly updated “ticker” of food insecurity data on its website <https://hungerfreecolorado.org> Current statistics show that:

- 33% of Coloradans are struggling to access nutritious food
 - 44% of households with children lack access to nutritious food
 - The average SNAP* benefit per meal in Colorado is \$1.29
- [*Federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program]

And, we all see food prices continue to rise.



No one person can change the world, but you can change the lives of 20, 50, maybe 100 people. Because of you, they won't have to worry about being hungry tomorrow, next week, next month, next year. You are part of a community – the Westview Presbyterian Church, Round Pantry, Round Urban Garden - that is made up of caring, compassionate people. Together, we're affecting countless lives. If you are ready to change your little corner of the world? Here are some ideas for getting started today!

1. Donate funds and/or food to The Round Pantry. (At our most recent Pantry we distributed food to **430** households and in the week's total distribution reached **966** households - exceeding the previous 2022 high.)

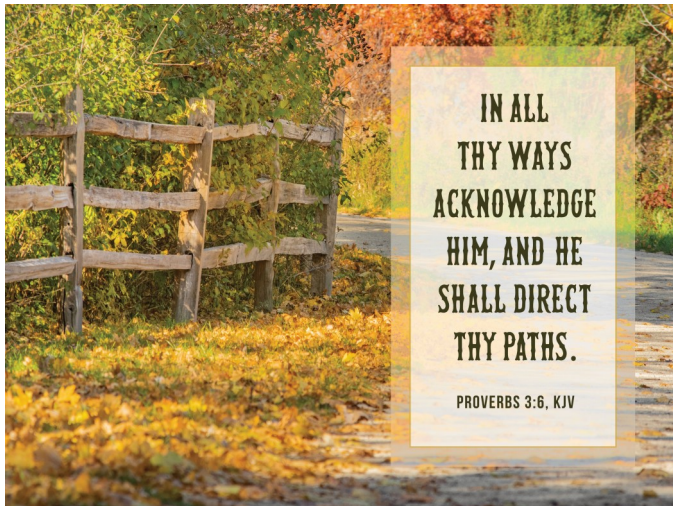
