Dear Westview,

Kick-off Sunday is just around the corner on September 11th!

This fall we will be introducing a "rhythm" of spiritual formation at Westview. Due to the busyness of life, our changing culture, and the age and stage of many members of our church, we are introducing new opportunities to engage in spiritual growth and development through a weekly, monthly, and quarterly rhythm:

A. A Weekly Rhythm

Wednesday morning 10am: Contemplative prayer practice with Bible or book study led by Dr. Dan beginning Wednesday September 7th – November 19th in The Damascus Room.

Community Garden: Meets Wednesday and Saturdays at 8am; and "Picnic Church" is every second and fourth Thursday at 6:30pm.

Pantry: Second and fourth Tuesday of the month. You can select your time to serve through sign-up genius on the website.

B. Monthly Sunday Rhythm

Each Sunday we will offer a different invitation for spiritual depth and discipleship.

First Sunday of the Month: Modifying the order of worship so that the celebration of the Lord's Supper is the main focus of the worship experience instead of the same order of worship with the Lord's Supper inserted in addition to everything else we do each Sunday.

Second Sunday of the Month: April – November: "Storytelling walk in the wild." This is a nature-based spiritual practice that Dr. Dan does in his wilderness guiding and outlined in his book "Finding Your Wild." Location: RMNP, Highlands Camp, or a semi-wild local place.

December through March: Conversations led by Dr. Dan on aging and elderhood. Resources include "Age-ing to Sageing" by Rabbi Zalman; and "Come of Age: the case for Elderhood" by Stephen Jenkinson; Conscious Eldering by Ron Pevny;

exploring the eight stages of growth and development as outlined in "Nature and the Human Soul" by Bill Plotkin; Held at 11am in The Gathering Place (TGP)

Third Sunday of the Month: "Exploring The True Self" (based on John 3 and 14-15, Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 4:22-24 and many other texts) teaching and conversation led by Dr. Dan in TGP at 11am. "The Immortal Diamond" and "The Universal Christ" by Richard Rohr will be our first resources to experience more deeply what it means to be created in the image of God.

Fourth Sunday of the Month: "Coffee with the Pastor" every other month or as needed. Coffee with the Pastor is an informal Q and R for newcomers to Westview with Dr. Dan, particularly around the vision, mission, and membership at Westview but may include other questions as well.

To review, we have new gatherings coming to Westview in the fall, particularly a mid-week Bible and/or book study; and gatherings after coffee fellowship on the second and third Sundays.

In addition, I will be leading **three town hall meetings** with the facilities master plan team that has been meeting since the spring. We have a lot of information for you and the town hall's will take place after worship on **Sunday**, **October 2**^{nd,} **9**th, and **Stewardship Sunday October 30**th.

It is going to be a great fall!

As summer ends and seasons change, things at The ROUND PANTRY remain the same, but are changing, too. So, a brief update:

The Round Pantry continues to serve the greater Longmont area by providing nutritious food the second and fourth weeks of each month. The number of people accessing The Round Pantry through Drive Line and Community Distribution is growing. At the end of August, The Round Pantry saw 400 (households) in the Drive Line and provided food to 538 for a total again of over 900 households. Food prices and rent increases are putting people in increasingly impossible situations.

Community Food Share continues to supply food for those who come to The Round Pantry. But, supply chain delays and delivery issues combined with high prices for food are reducing the amount of food available on order.

The Round Pantry receives generous donations that make it possible to purchase food when supplies fall short of needs.
