## PASTOR'S PEN

MAY 2023 NEWSLETTER

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you . . ." Jesus of Nazareth, Acts 1:8

Dear Westview.

My guess is we don't relate too much to the above verse in the Book of Acts because we are not feeling very powerful these days. Life has a way of humbling us. We would like more power over things, especially since the Greek word for power is "dunamis," from which we get the English word "dynamite."

Of course, Jesus isn't talking about power "over" things in this verse. On Pentecost Sunday (May 28th) we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and remember the "dunamis" of the Holy Spirit is the power to witness: "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses . . . ." The power is to witness Christ and what theologians call "The Paschal Mystery" (Paschal meaning "Passover") of death, resurrection, and rebirth.

In this month of May, let us consider what is alive in us, but also what is falling away. What are the new surrenders God is calling us to? This is a great witness to the life of discipleship for which God calls us. What areas of our lives are we witnessing and embracing the constant cycle of death and resurrection?

As we finish up a long-awaited spring season, we want to update you on The Round Pantry. As many of you may already know, the recent reduction in SNAP benefits has left many families in our community struggling to put food on the table. [Recent Congressional action ended the SNAP Emergency Allotments that were in place - due to COVID - as of the end of March 2023. hungerfreecolorado.org/] As a result, we have large numbers of people coming to the Round Pantry for assistance.

In the month of March alone, we served over 2200 households providing them with much-needed food. Our volunteers have been working tirelessly to process and package food and get the food to our shoppers in the Drive Line or through Community Distribution. We are so grateful for our volunteers' dedication and hard work!

We need to highlight two realities within the level of need:

- We have an increased need for volunteers and have added task slots to our volunteer sign ups.
- We are currently having to purchase about half of the shelf-stable products that are distributed (i.e. canned soup, canned fruit & vegetables, canned tuna, plain rice, boxed and canned meals.)

It's important to remember that anyone can experience food insecurity, regardless of their background or circumstances. Many of the individuals and families who come to the Round Pantry are facing unexpected financial challenges, such as rent increases, medical bills, or other emergencies. The Round Pantry provides a crucial safety net for these individuals and helps ensure that they have access to nutritious food.

As a faith community, we can all play a role in supporting The Round Pantry whether it's through making a donation, volunteering your time, or spreading the word about the pantry's services. Together, we make a difference in the lives of those who are struggling in our community
